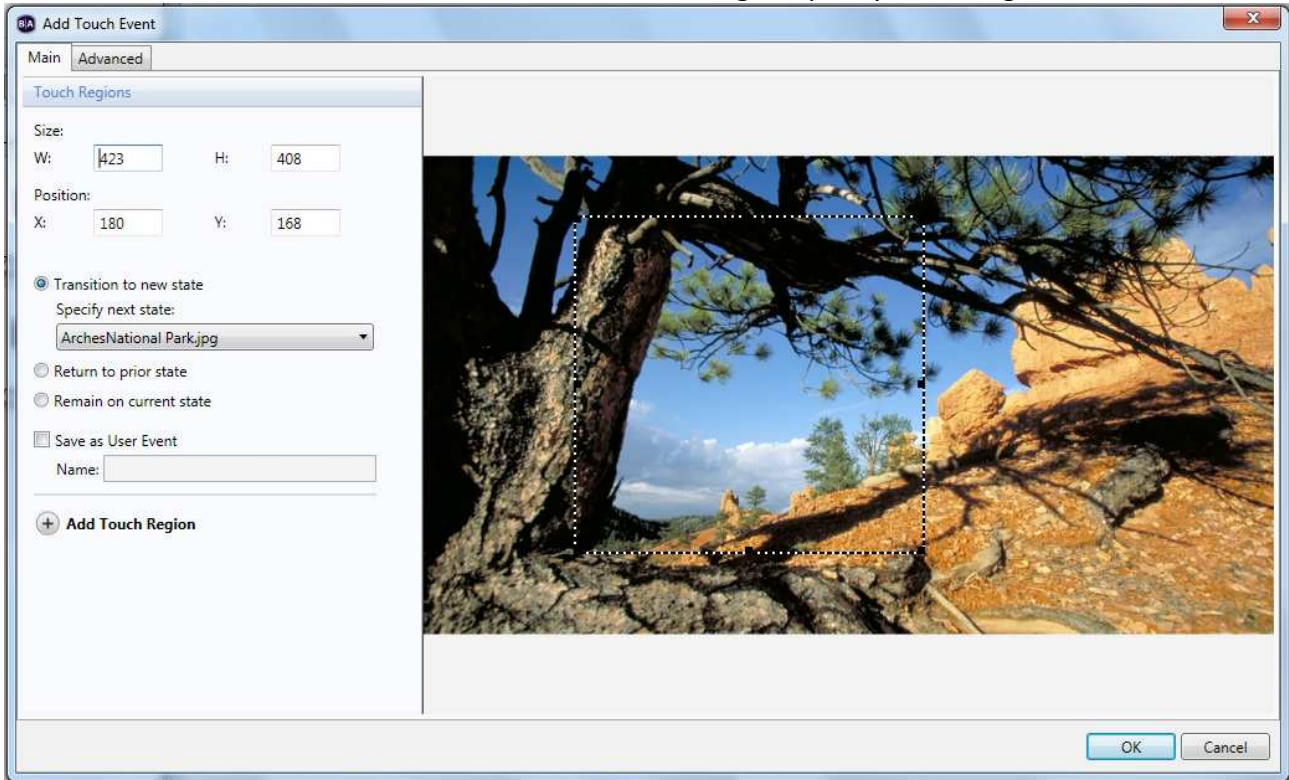
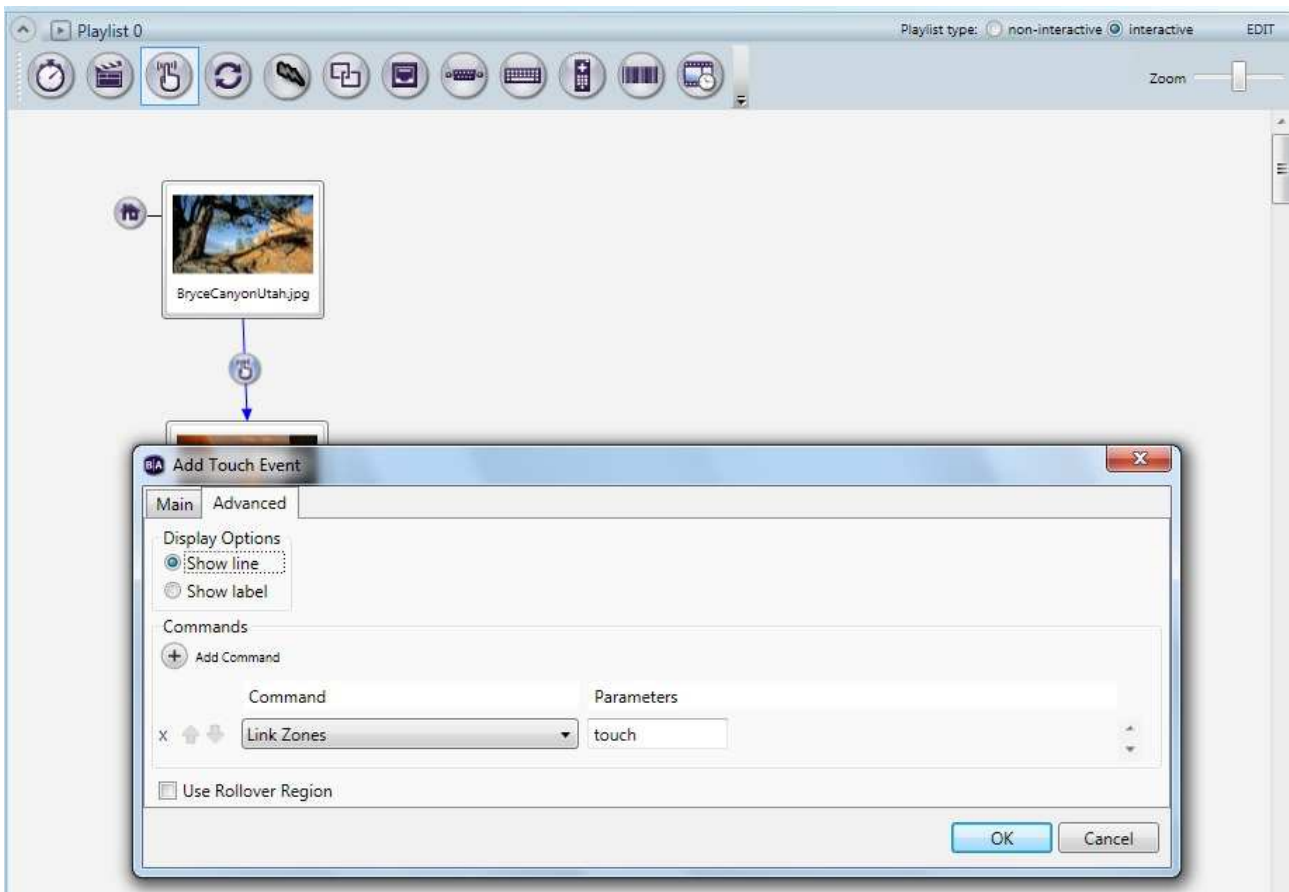

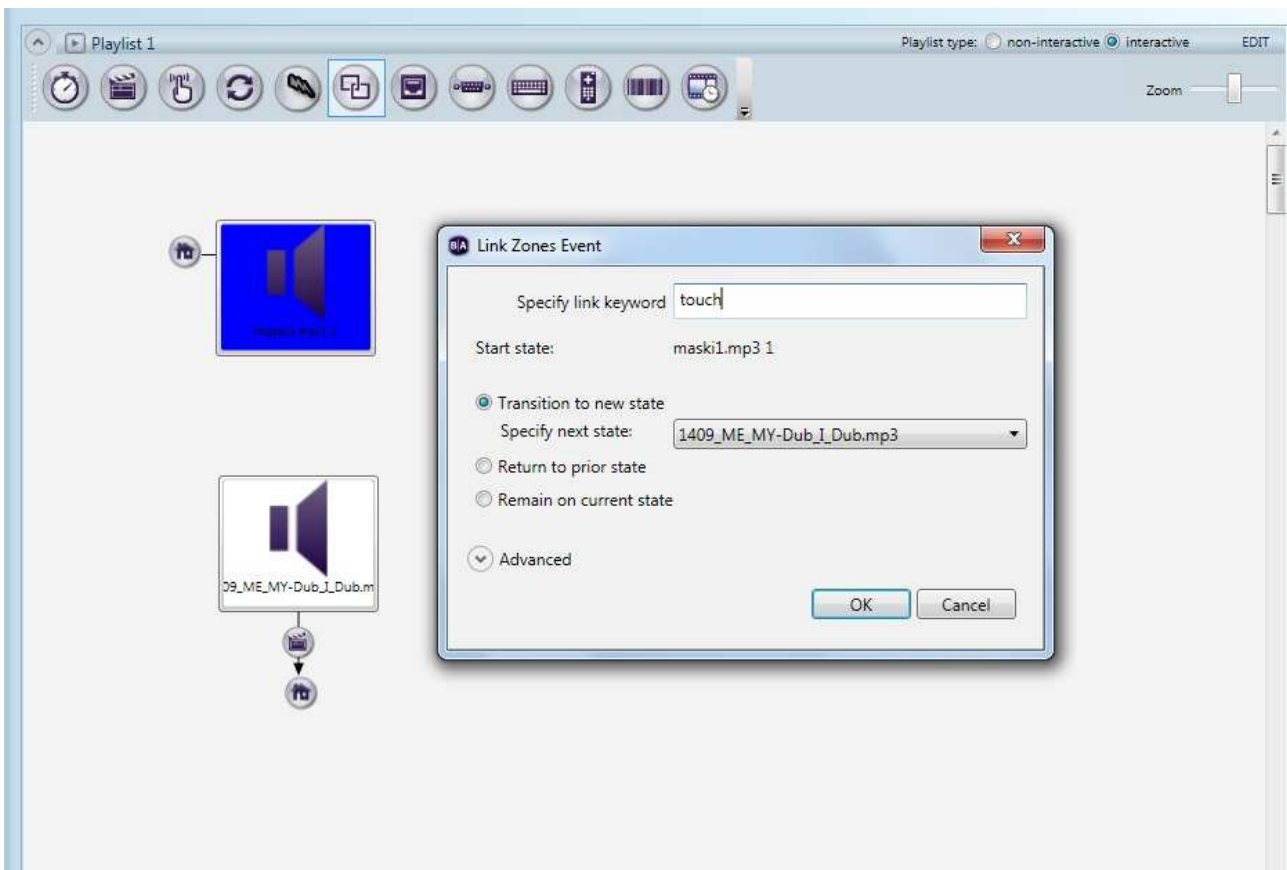
1. In BrightAuthor create new presentation (File – New Presentation), add appropriate presentation settings.
2. Click on Layout and add Audio only zone, then click on Playlist.
3. Select Video or Images zone, tick "interactive" in front of Playlist type and drag images to playlist area.
4. Select Touch event and use it to connect two images. Specify touch region:



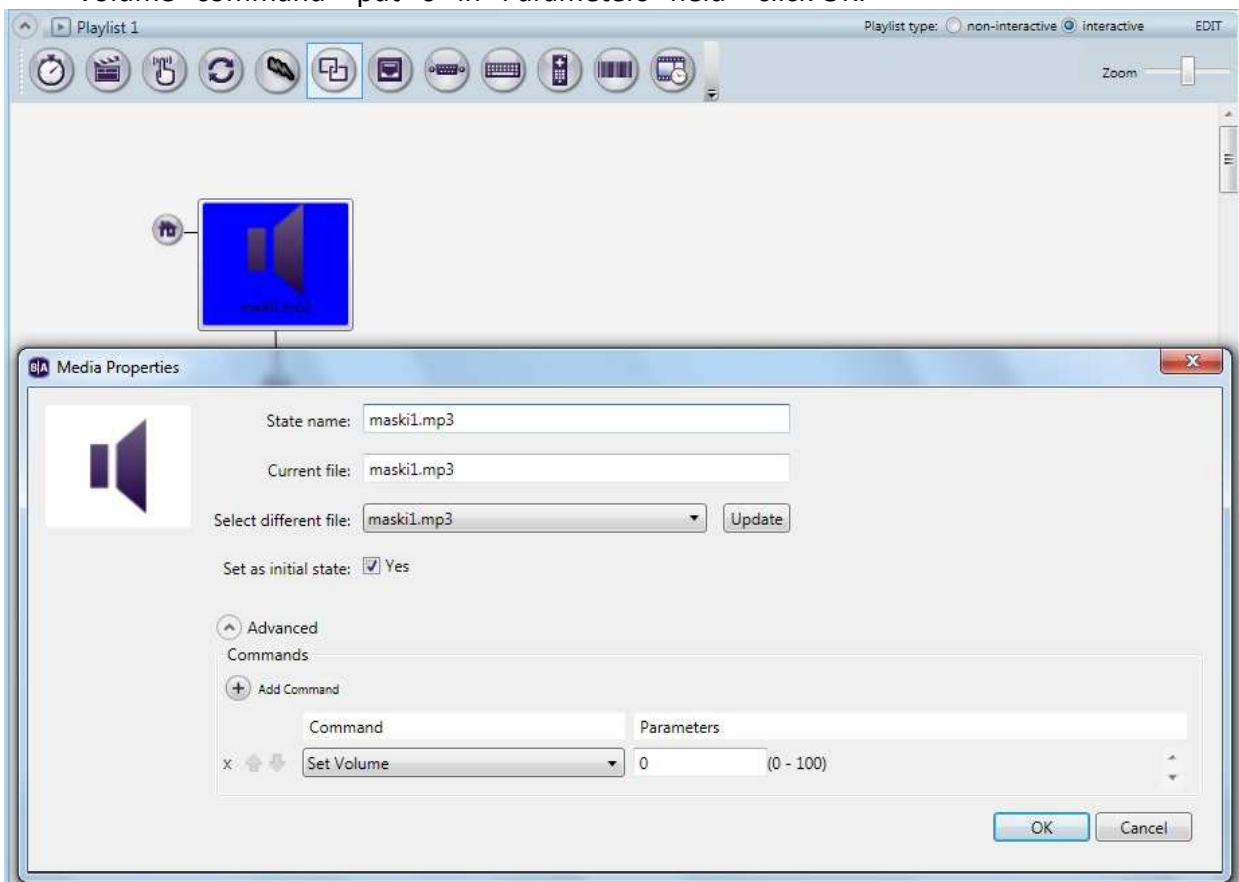
Then click on: Advanced – Add command – select "Link Zones" command – in "Parameters" field type what you want (e.g. "touch") – click OK.



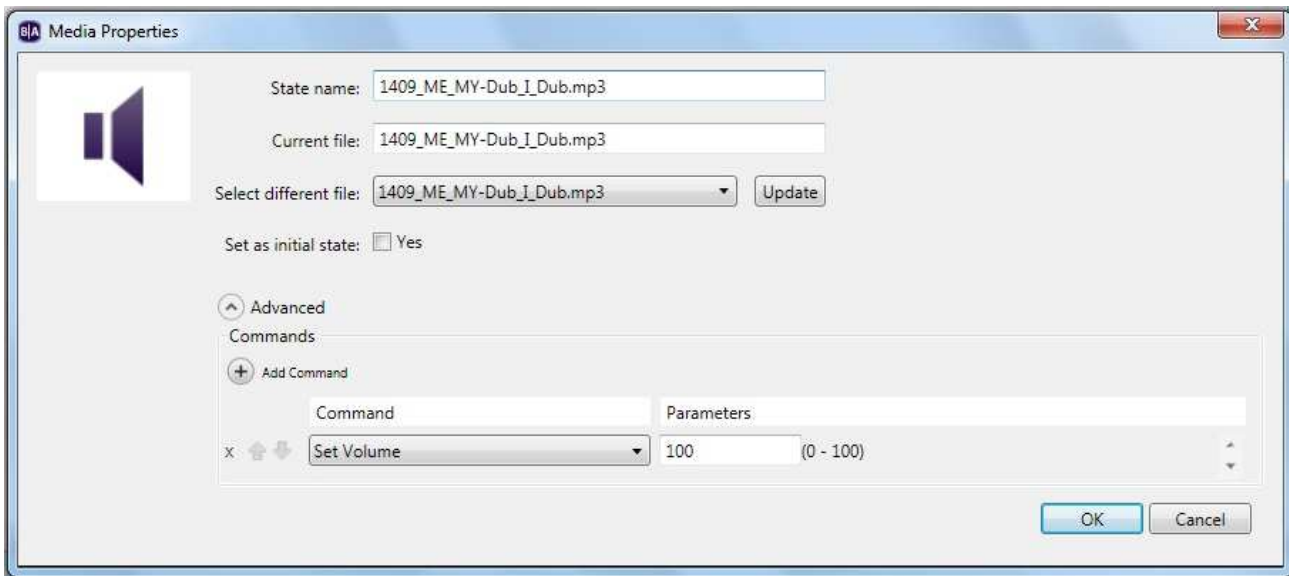
5. Select your Audio zone, tick "interactive" in front of Playlist type and drag mp3 files to it. First mp3 would be as initial file without sound to activate Link Zones command.
6. Select Link Zones event (icon) and use it to connect two mp3s – type "touch" in "Specify link keyword" field – click OK.



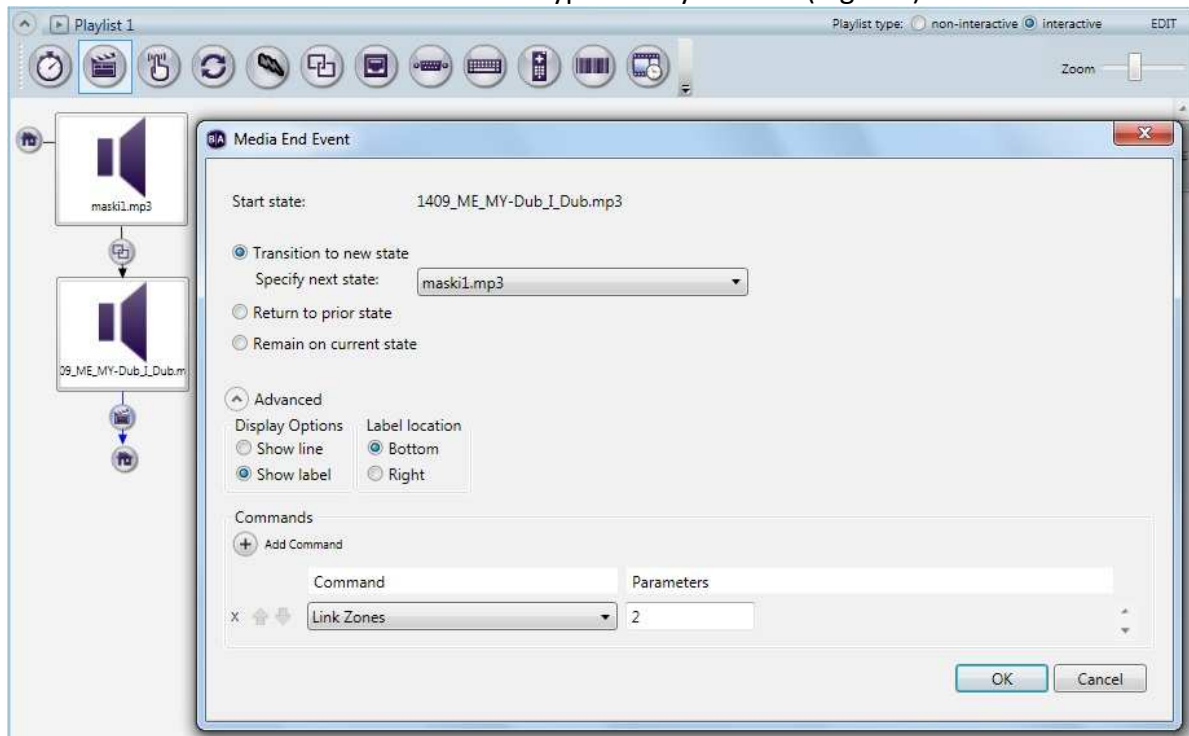
7. Double click on first (initial) mp3 file, click on: Advanced – Add command – select "Set Volume" command – put "0" in "Parameters" field – click OK.



8. Double click on second mp3 file (you wish to play in sync with image activated by touch), click on: Advanced – Add command – select "Set Volume command" – put "100" in "Parameters" field – click OK.

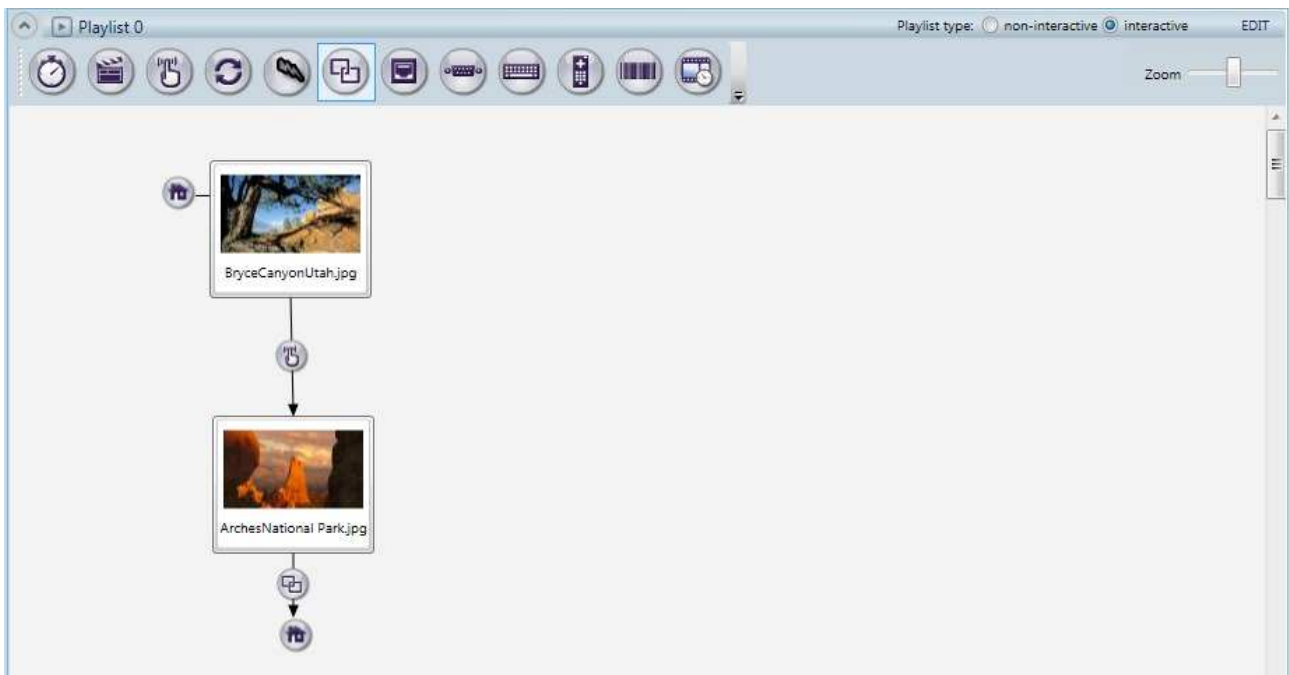


9. Select "Media end" event and use it to connect 2<sup>nd</sup> mp3 file with 1<sup>st</sup> (initial mp3 file). Double click on this event – click on Advanced – Add command – select "Link Zones" command – in "Parameters" field type what you want (e.g. "2") – click OK.

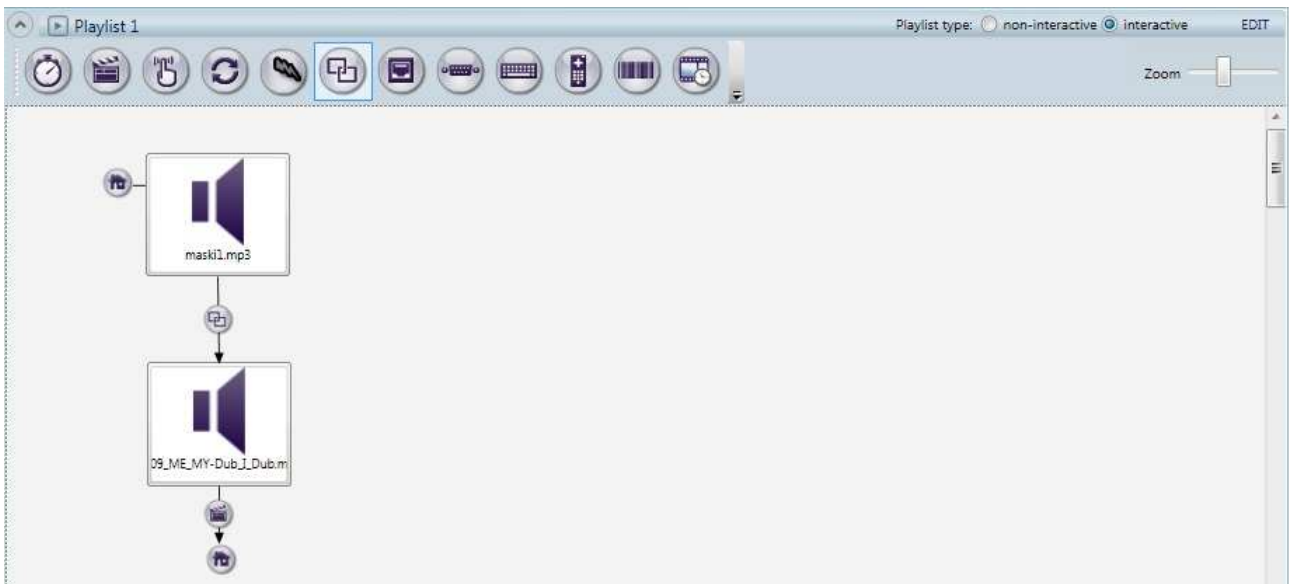


10. Select Video or Images zone – select "Link Zone" event (icon) and use it to connect 2<sup>nd</sup> image with 1<sup>st</sup> - Type "2" in "Specify link keyword" field – click OK.

Your Video or Images zone should look like:



Your Audio zone should like like:



11. Save your presentation and publish it.
